- **More than one team can register & participate** from a particular Institution in the 1st National Virtual Legal Literary Event, 2021.
- No one is allowed to disclose their identity during the competition.
- This competition is solely organized through online platform.
- Only online payments can be entertained in this regard.

SPECIFIC RULES

I. ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

Topic- **Religious Beliefs over Environmental Protection**

Rules-

1. **Maximum two authors** are allowed.
2. Language of the competition shall be English.
3. Word limit is 1000-1500 words
4. The text font of the essay must be in Times New Roman, size 12 with 1.5 line spacing. The font size of foot notes must be 10.
5. The essay must be prepared in the Blue Book citation (20th Edition) format.
6. The participants shall be examined on the following criteria:
 - a. Content
 - b. Language and Expression
 - c. Grammar
 - d. Less than 20 % plagiarism
 - e. Uniform referencing and footnoting
7. Under all circumstances, the decision of the judges shall be final and binding.

8. The participants has to submit their essay latest by **9th June, 2021** by 5:00 p.m. at literaryevent2021@sgtuniversity.org

IV. DEBATE COMPETITION

Topic- **Rising Women Protection Laws are hampering innocent masculinity in Modern India**

Rules-

1. Medium of speech is English.
2. Team composition: 2 members (one for the motion and one against the motion).
3. Time given to every participant of each team is 3+1 minutes.
4. Use of profanity, slang and offensive language is strictly prohibited and will amount to instant disqualification.
5. Use of Quotations shall be allowed only from valid sources.
6. Under all circumstances, the decision of the judges shall be final and binding.
7. Participants have to keep their video mode on at the time of their presentation.
8. Only formals will be allowed.
9. The speakers shall be examined on the following criteria:
 - a. Content
 - b. Language
 - c. Arguments and Eloquence
 - d. Spontaneity and Presence of mind

Prizes to be awarded:

- e. **Best Team Award** – Cash Prize: **1500/-**
- f. **Runner-Up Team Award** – Cash Prize: **1100/-**
- g. **Best Speaker Award** – Cash Prize: **700/-**

V. EXTEMPORE

1. This is an individual event i.e. the team shall consist of one participant only.
2. The language of competition shall be English.
3. Each participant will be given 2 minutes to think and 2 minutes to speak.

4. The student volunteer will pick up a random chit having a topic from the bunch of chits bearing various topics.
5. Participants have to keep their video mode on at the time of their presentation.
6. Only formals will be allowed.
9. The participants shall be examined on the following criteria:
 - a. Poise/Self-confidence, eye contact, enthusiasm
 - b. Presence of mind
 - c. voice projection
 - d. Persuasiveness
 - e. Clear presentation of ideas

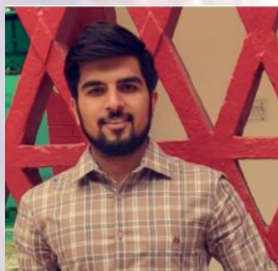
