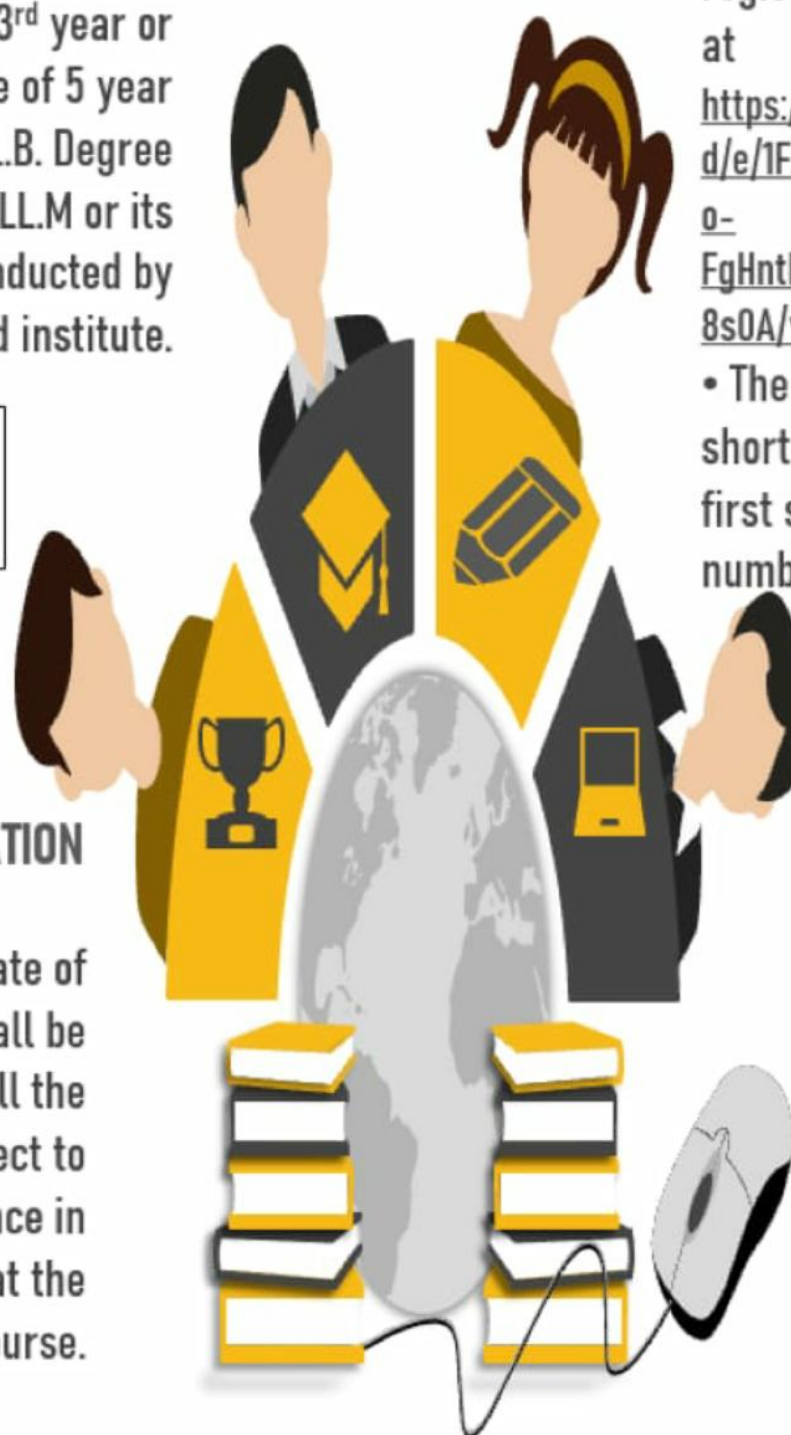
A certificate of completion shall be provided to all the participants subject to the performance in the assignment at the end of the course.

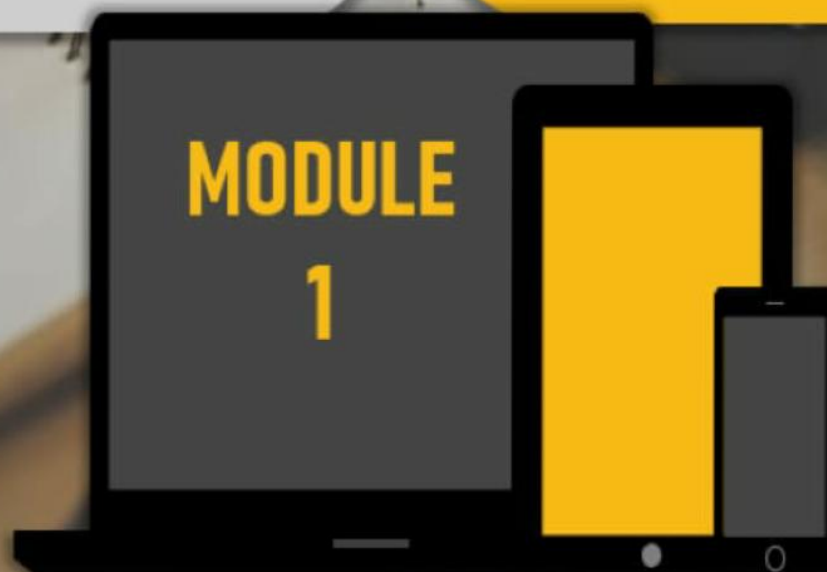
