THE MOOT PROPOSITION

The theme of the moot proposition for this edition shall be multidisciplinary, centered on Information Technology Law. In this rapidly advancing world, technology is ever changing and has completely revolutionized the world since it's inception. The proposition shall deal with the laws concerning Information Technology, alongside other subjects to enhance the knowledge of students in this field...

TEAM ELIGIBILITY AND COMPOSITION

Students pursuing an undergraduate degree (3-year LLB programme or a 5-year integrated LLB programme) shall be eligible to participate in the 6th NMCC, 2022. Each team shall comprise three members (two speakers and one researcher); two-member teams are strictly ineligible to participate.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Institutes that wish to participate in the competition are expected to provisionally register via the link below. Please note that this is not the final registration.

- 2. To confirm the registration, teams have to fill the registration form and make an initial payment of INR 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) on or before the last date to register.
- 3. A memorial qualifier round shall be conducted for the registered teams.
- 4. The teams that qualify the memorial round, thereby advancing to the oral rounds shall be required to make a final payment of INR 2,500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred Only) on or before the last date to register.

TENTATIVE FEE AND PAYMENT

A registration fee of INR 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only, inclusive of GST) is to be paid at the time of registration for the competition by all the teams and INR 2500/- to be paid by teams qualifying the memorial qualification round. Registration fee is inclusive of GST and is to be paid via wire transfer only.
