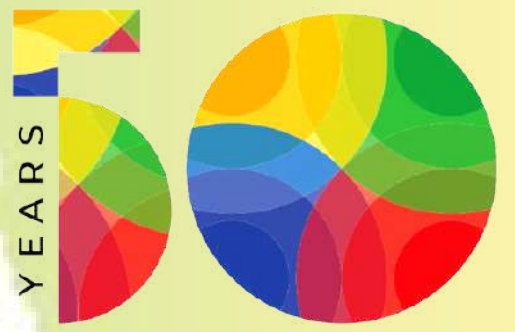






Let's meet at Kochi on March 25th!!!

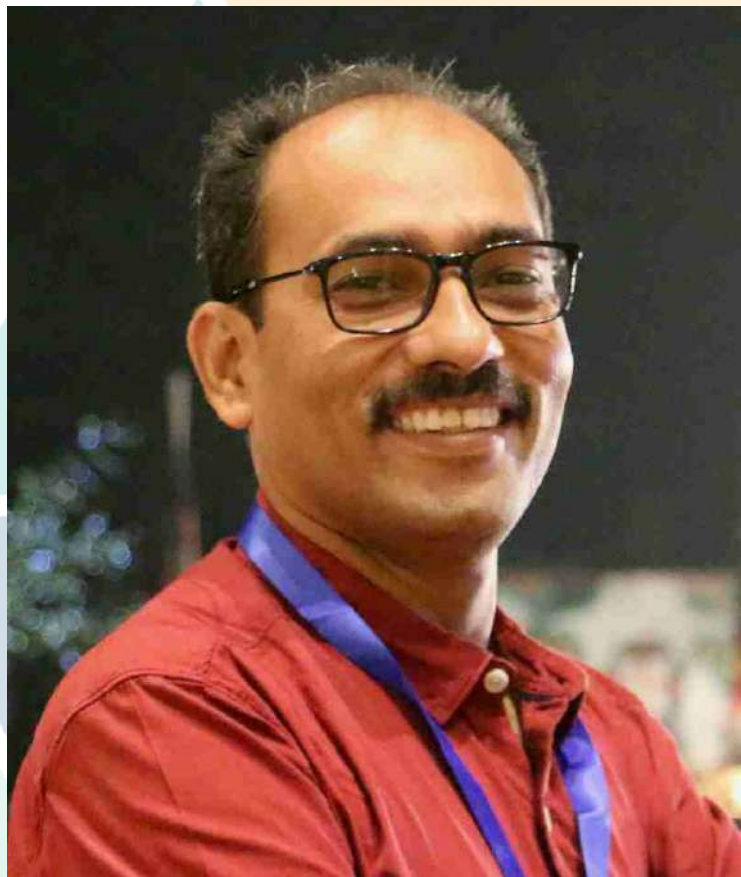
Message from Patron

Model United Nations (MUN) is an academic simulation of the United Nations where students play the role of delegates from different countries. MUN aims to bring out the best of real-life skills in the participants such as diplomacy, effective communication, negotiation, oratory skills etc. by finding an optimal solution to the many multifaceted problems that affect humanity. With each participant representing a country, we discuss the real-world issues that humanity now faces; and attempt to solve them with policies and perspectives of their assigned nation.

WHY CUSAT?

Cochin University of Science and Technology (CUSAT), constituted to develop higher education, and research in applied science, technology, industry, humanities, and commerce, has consecutively been figured in the Times Higher Education World Ranking since 2017. CUSAT has also found its place in the QS World University Ranking and the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) of the Indian Government, re-accredited with NAAC 'A Grade'. CUSAT has also bagged the Chancellor's Best University Award for 3 years. WHY CUSAT MUN?

The Inaugural Edition of the CUSAT Model United Nations (1.0) conference was held on 8th-10th of February 2019 with 200+ participants from across the country, making it one of the largest institutional MUN conferences in Kerala. Applauded with great compliments and responses, the Second Edition of CUSAT MUN (2.0) was held in the same year from 20th-22nd of September. The second edition was undoubtedly a huge success with over 300 delegates nationwide. The Committees were chaired by well-known figures from the Indian MUN Circuit. There were five committees namely UN General Assembly- Disarmament and International Security Committee (UNGA DISEC), United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC), All India Political Parties Meet (AIPPM), Crisis Committee, International Press (IP). DISEC stands out with its participation of more than 100 delegates and AIPPM ended up being a trailblazer in Kerala's MUNs with its tremendous acknowledgement and appraisals. This year we introduce the COP 27 committee, realizing the urgent need to save our planet and to take immediate action. We believe with all our hearts that COP 27 would also become a trendsetter for the future MUNs urging the student leaders to take immediate action.





WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- Become acquainted with global issues: MUNs expand one's knowledge about global issues as it obligates every delegate to understand them and their opinion may contribute to solve the problems that affect our planet today.
- Nurture Public Speaking: MUN provides a great setting where people can try to face their fear of public speaking. This chance to overcome a fear of public speaking is great because it supports delegates' personal growth and triggers self-confidence.
- Develop Diplomacy and negotiation skills: Model UN conferences are diplomatic simulations. Respect and cooperation are the fundamentals of the debate. MUN teaches you how to be a good diplomat with increased your diplomacy and negotiation skill which could be achieved through the process of lobbying other participants to agree with your interests.
- Enhance leadership skill: Participants develop confidence and leadership skills through experience. As representative of a country, one will make a decision as a leader. Model UN conferences are opportunities to practice research, public speaking, teamwork, negotiation, and writing skills in a safe and structured environment.
- Exposure to perspectives and cultures: A Model UN conference is a concentration of delegates with different perspectives and from different cultures in the same place for a few days. This contact with different perspectives and settings is very useful to help you grow at a personal level and expand your horizons.

The United Nations General Assembly First Committee (also known as the Disarmament and International Security Committee or DISEC) one of six main committees at the General Assembly of the United Nations. It deals with disarmament, global challenges, and threats to international peace. This Committee allows its member states to deliberate on the maintenance of international peace and security, as well as principles governing disarmament and the regulation of armaments, promotion of cooperative arrangements and measures aimed at strengthening stability through lower levels of armaments.

The United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) established in 2006, is an inter-governmental body within the United Nations system responsible for strengthening the promotion and protection of human rights around the globe and for addressing situations of human rights violations and making recommendations on them. This committee will allow the delegates to raise concerns over human rights violations and have thematic discussions on them, enabling a free flow of opinion. It is one of the most interesting bodies concerning itself with human rights issues such as the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, LGBT rights, women's rights etc.

All India Political Party Meets are conventions that allow the diverse political groups of India to reach a consensus on decisions of national importance before sessions began. It aims to mimic the reality by reproducing the stages of policies and jurisdiction, with delegates representing personalities from the divergent group of Indian political parties. The AIPPM Committee, unlike the other conventional MUN committee, is characterized by unrestricted political debate, cross talks, and high levels of negotiations focussing on emulating political realities by bringing to light various layers of polity and governance in India.

The Conference of Parties, known as COP, is the decision-making body responsible for monitoring and reviewing the implementation of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change. It brings together the countries that have signed the Framework Convention. The COP assesses the effects of the measures taken by Parties and the progress made in achieving the ultimate objective of the Convention. To combat dangerous human interference with the climate system, the parties review the implementation of the Convention and take decisions necessary to promote the effective implementation of the Convention, including institutional and administrative arrangements.
